



Incidentals

Your credit card was pre-authorized \$150 for in-room incidentals at check-in. Upon your departure, any room incidental charges—as well as the cost of any damaged or missing items from your suite, including bath amenities, outdoor furniture, and kitchenware—will be billed to your credit card on file.

Smoking

AutoCamp is a non-smoking property. If you smoke inside youraccommodation, you will be charged a minimum cleaning fee of \$350. Due to fire dangers, anyone found smoking on property may be asked to check out. The non-smoking policy refers to cigarettes, cigars, cannabis, e-cigarettes, and burning of candles or incense.

Security & Safety

Management is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged articles. Please report any problems with your suite to an AutoCamp team member immediately. We adhere to all state, county and local laws.

Good Neighbor Policy

The design of AutoCamp fosters a community experience between guests. Because of this, please be courteous to other guests around you. Loud, objectionable noise is not allowed at any time, nor is amplified music allowed. Profanity and violence will not be tolerated. Inconsiderate guests will be asked to leave without refund.

Dog Policy

Dogs are welcome at AutoCamp for an additional fee of \$75.00 per stay (maximum two dogs).

- Not all AutoCamp suites are dog friendly, and you must call the property to receive prior approval.
- Dogs must be kept on a maximum 6-foot leash at all times and may not be left unattended.
- Guest are responsible for cleaning up after their dog.
 Dispose of dog waste in one of the dog receptacles.
 AutoCamp is not responsible for and will hold owner accountable for any injury or damage caused by your dog.

Kid's Code

We welcome kids of all ages to AutoCamp. We ask that parents hold their children to high standards of behavior and respect for other guests. We ask that parents watch their children at all times and ensure that they are complying with our quiet hours, behavior policies, and privacy rules.

Parking

There is one parking space available per suite. Parking is available in front of the Clubhouse and wagons are provided to cart your luggage to your suite. If you have more than one car, please seethe front desk for alternate parking arrangements.

Guests & Visitors

You may have visitors come to AutoCamp during daytime hours. All guests must sign-in at the Clubhouse. Guests that are not part of your reservation may not stay on property overnight.

Outdoor Cooking

Your suite is equipped with BBQ tools and basic cookware, and Cabins have a kitchenette. Each suite is gifted 2 logs and a firestarter to help start your own fire. Firewood Bundles are available for purchase at the General Store.

Wildlife & Bugs

AutoCamp brings us all closer to nature. Deer, raccoons, squirrels, turkeys, coyotes, mosquitos, foxes and ticks are all part of being in nature. We ask that you not leave food or trash outdoors overnight and that all trash is thrown away in covered receptacles provided around the property. If you encounter wildlife on property, do not approach or feed them.

Wood Burning

Please do not gather wood from the surrounding area to use as fuel. Firewood Bundles for campfires is available in the General Store. Should weather conditions require us to temporarily ban campfires, we would welcome you to enjoy one of our community fire pits.




Concierge

The AutoCamp Team is happy to assist you with planning your adventures in the Catskills. Head to the Clubhouse and pick up a list of our favorite local restaurants and wineries, hiking trails, and sites to see.

General Store

The General Store is located inside the Clubhouse. Here, you'll find a variety of artisanal snacks, beverages, barbecue kits, AutoCamp apparel, souvenirs, extra fire starter kits, and ice.

Breakfast & Coffee

Each morning, join us in the Clubhouse for complimentary coffee, tea, and granola from 7-11amam. There is also a selection of coffee and tea in your suite should you want to sleep in.

Bicycles

A limited number of complimentary mountain bikes are available for day use on a first-come, first-serve basis. Helmets and locks are provided. If you'd like to check out a bike, please see an AutoCamp team member in the Clubhouse.

Board Games & Lawn Games


The Clubhouse and surrounding areas are stocked with a variety of classic board games and lawn games. All games are available on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Clubhouse Restrooms

Restrooms are located in the Clubhouse. Luxury Tent guests may use our Clubhouse showers during their stay. Our showers are stocked with Ursa Major organic bath products, towels, and hair dryers.



Airstream Windows



Airstream windows can often stick and may be difficult to open. Please open windows carefully to prevent damage, and never force your window open or closed. Window breakage may occur. Please see an AutoCamp team member if you need assistance.

Fans



There is a fan in your suite bathroom. We suggest turning your fan on when you are running the shower. Fans will not operate and will close automatically if it's raining or if there is heavy dew.


Wall Heaters & Galley Air Conditioning



For heating - use the wall heaters to the left of the front door and in the bedroom.

For air conditioning - press the large button on the thermostat once to wake it up, then use the large button to change the setting to cool, adjusting the temperature with the up and down arrows. To turn it off, click the large button until the display shows off.


Galley Heating and Air Conditioning



If you do not have wall heaters, your thermostat is located by the kitchen sink. **For heating,** press the system button until it says heat, then press the mode button until it says heat and gas, then adjust the temperature to your desired level. Please do not set temperature above 73 on heat / gas.

For air conditioning, press the system button until it says cool. Then press the mode button until you see the snowflake symbol. Adjust the temperature to your desired level. No lower than 68 degrees **

Bluetooth Sound System




Each suite is equipped with a multi-device charging station and Bluetooth controls for playing media from your wireless device. To pair your device, locate the controls next to your sofa. Turn on the power switch and press the pairing button on the top left. You'll see a flashing blue light indicating that the system is ready to pair with your device. 


Air Conditioning & Heating




To operate the thermostat, press the large button once to "wake up" the thermostat. Use the large button to change setting to FAN or COOL for A/C, or HEAT. Adjust the temperature with the up and down arrows. To turn off, click the large button until the display shows OFF.

Skylight & Blinds




Your blinds and skylight cover are controlled by the remote mounted on the wall near your bed.

Cooking



Our cabins includes an electric stovetop for cooking. Pots and Pans are located in the drawer below the stovetop.

Bluetooth Sound System



Each suite is equipped with a multi-device charging station and Bluetooth controls for playing media from your wireless device. To pair your device, locate the controls next to your sofa. Turn on the power switch and press the pairing button on the top left. You'll see a flashing blue light indicating that the system is ready to pair with your device. In the Bluetooth settings on your device, select "pyle in wall". Adjust the volume and you're all set.



Food Storage

Your tent is equipped with a mini fridge to store food. Bagged ice is available for purchase at the Shop. Please be sure all food is stored and inside your tent when not in use, and zip your tent closed when leaving.

Clubhouse Restrooms

Tent guests are welcome to use the restrooms and showers located in the Clubhouse, which are open 24 hours access through back entrance door near the water refill station and restrooms. Please bring your towel from your tent with you.

Heating and Cooling

Each tent is outfitted with several windows, a heater and fan, and a heated blanket.

Power and Electricity

There is a power strip to provide electricity near your headboard.

Sink in Clubhouse for Tents

Use the sinks just outside the Clubhouse to rinse out/clean dishes. There is dish soap and a sponge at the sink for your convenience.

AutoCamp team members are onsite 24 hours a day.

Fire Safety

There is a fire extinguisher located in your suite underneath the sink cabinet. In case of fire, please use your extinguisher and notify an AutoCamp team member immediately.

Suite Security

Make sure your suite door is tightly shut and locked when you leave.

Never leave fires unattended.

Always put out fires before going to sleep.

Always keep a water bucket or fire extinguisher nearby when making a fire.

Keep flames low and remain at a safe distance from the fire.


